

Champagnes and Sparkling Wines

1. Dom Perignon £120.00
A stupendous champagne. Made with equal proportions of pinot noir and chardonnay to create a delightful crispness on the palate.
2. Veuve Cliquot “Yellow Label” £50.00
Rich, ripe pinot noir dominated, impressive as always.
3. Moet et Chandon, Brut Imperial £45.00
Classically a third of each pinot noir, pinot mernier and chardonnay, providing delightfully dry crisp champagne.
4. Berri Estates Brut Rosé (Australia) £19.50
This sparkler is brimming with summer fruit flavour. It is made in an easy drinking style that makes it suitable for all occasions.
5. Berri Estates Cuvee Brut (Australia) £18.50
A soft, fruity, lively sparkler. It is easy drinking with excellent fruit flavour and good length.
6. Asti Spumate, Sant Orsola (Italy) £16.00
This well loved sparkling wine is highly aromatic with the classic bouquet of the moscato grape.

7. Footsteps Sauvignon Blanc (Chile)
This is crisp dry wine with a fresh gooseberry flavour and a zingy acidity.
8. Footsteps Chardonnay (Australia)
This is a fresh citrusy wine with good texture and a subtle hint of oak on the finish.
9. Footsteps Liebfraumilch (Germany)
Made using a blend of the rivaner, riesling and the scheurebe grape, it has a medium, grapey style.
10. Footsteps Rosé (California)
Made predominately from the zinfandel grape, it is lively and fruity and exploding with red berry flavours.
11. Footsteps Merlot (Languedoc)
This wine is juicy, richly flavoured with supple tannins and has lively aromas of redcurrant and black cherry.
12. Footsteps Shiraz (Australia)
Rich, vibrant red berry fruit bursting with spicy blackberry aromas and a dash of toasty oak.

Dry and Delicate Whites

13. Cloudy Bay Sauvignon Blanc (New Zealand) £34.00
Grassy overtones and a strong gooseberry finish. An outstanding example of New Zealand sauvignon blanc.
14. Chablis, Durup (Burgundy) £27.00
Classic chablis – unadulterated chardonnay! Steely, dry and crisp with a long lasting flavour.
15. Muscadet, Sevre et Maine (Loire) £14.00
A crisp dry white wine with an attractive and delicate fruity aroma.
16. Hardys “The Riddle” Semillon-Chardonnay (Australia) £14.00
This wine has a typically soft creamy texture, limey flavours and subtle oak overtones.
17. Vita Chardonnay- Pinot Grigio del Veneto (Italy) £10.95
A light refreshing fruity wine dominated by the chardonnay grape.

Aromatic and Flowery Whites

18. Sancerre, Le crele (Loire) £26.00
A well made wine with vibrant fruit characteristics and a rich sauvignon bouquet.
19. Villa Maria Gewurtraminer (New Zealand) £23.00
Rich and spicy with exotic fruit flavours.
20. Canaletto Pinot Grigio/Garganega (Italy) £14.00
A blend of the fruity pinot grigio and the aromatic garganega producing a stunning citrusy dry wine.
21. Vouvray, Les Fouchets (Loire) £13.00
Produced from the chenin blanc grape this is a long standing favourite.

Smooth and Full Flavoured Whites

22. Chablis Premier Cru, ‘Fourchaume’, Durup, (Burgundy) £38.00
Mouth filling flavours, balanced fruit and acidity impart great finesse and character.
23. Hardys Nottage Hill Chardonnay (Australia) £17.00
A big buttery Australian chardonnay with plenty of fruit, toast and vanilla.

Light and Fruity Reds

24. Fleurie, Ch. de Fleurie (Beaujolais) £27.00
Luscious fruity red wine made from the gamay grape possessing easy drinking charm.
25. Marques de Morano, Rioja Tinto (Spain) £16.00
A lighter style of the fruity rioja with just a hint of a traditional oakiness made for early drinking.
26. Kleine Zalze Gamay/Noir (South Africa) £15.00
A blend of pinot noir and gamay grapes that produces a soft, fruity easy drinking wine.
27. Andes Peaks Merlot (Chile) £14.00
A soft supple wine with plummy peppery flavours.

Medium Reds

28. Gevrey Chambertin, Pierre Ponnelle, (Burgundy) £46.00
A full robust wine with finesse and breeding with rich concentrated pinot fruit.
29. Chateauneuf du Pape, Caves Saint Pierre (Rhône) £26.00
A young wine with a spicy bouquet, ripe fruit and a velvety finish.
30. Rioja Reserva, Coto de Imaz (Spain) £24.00
A remarkable, complex wine with a powerful tannic structure.
31. High Altitude Cabernet/Tempranillo (Argentina) £15.00
A complex, well balanced wine bursting with black cherries, plums and hints of vanilla.
32. Finca Flichman Oak Aged Cabernet Sauvignon (Argentina) £15.00
Deep coloured with typical blackcurrant fruit and sweet vanilla flavours.

Full Bodied Reds

33. Amarone della Valpolicella, Bolla (Italy) £46.00
Matured for 3 years in oak followed by another year in bottle, this is a very rich and concentrated wine. Produced from the excellent corvina grape this is regarded as one of the top reds from Italy.
34. Rioja Faustino 1, Gran Reserva (Spain) £32.00
This wine has complex fruit and warm tannins surrounded by vanilla oak flavours.
35. Chateaneuf du Pape, Reserve des Cardinaux (Rhône) £32.00
A mature vintage from 2001 providing a more full bodied, rich red wine.
36. Hardys Oomoo Shiraz (Australia) £25.00
A solid flavoursome wine with lots of rich juicy fruit and smooth tannins.
37. Ravenswood Old Vines Zinfandel (California) £25.00
This wine is matured in French oak for 18 months and has great power and complexity.
38. Hardys Nottage Hill Cabernet Shiraz (Australia) £17.00
Rich and full flavoured with spicy blackcurrant fruit and light oak.

Bollinger is a stylish champagne with hints of white fruit and a perfectly balanced fresh acidity.
- Mercier Brut Rosé £35.00

- Chateau de Rocques, St Emilion (Bordeaux) £22.00
This is a rich supple wine with excellent fruit and tannin balance.
